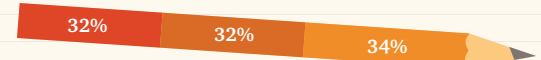

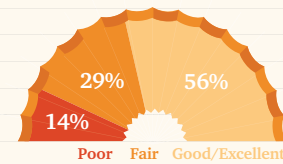
How well does it prepare you for what you're doing today, or what you'll do in the future?



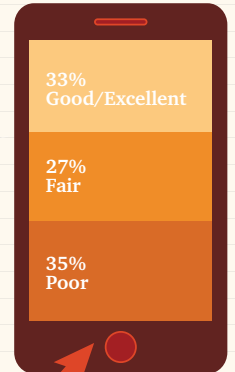
How well does it allow you to learn at your own pace?



How well does it adjust to your learning style and needs?

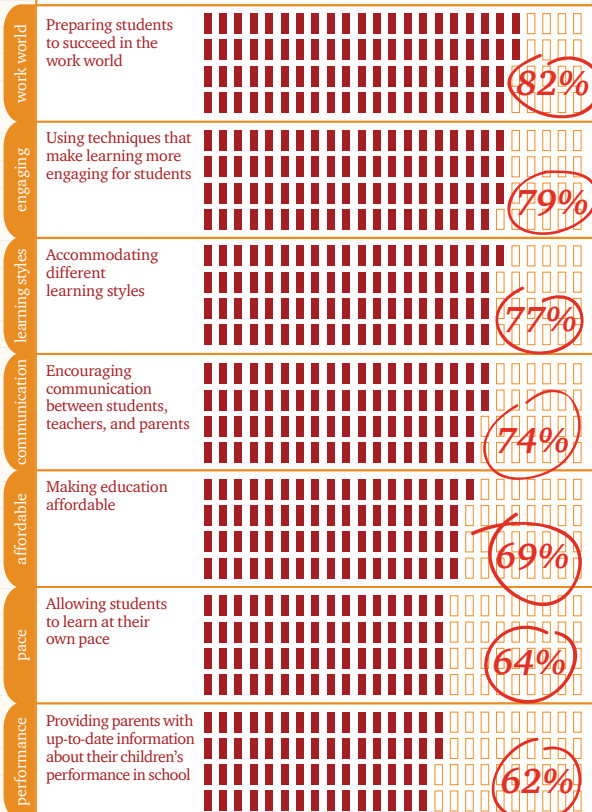

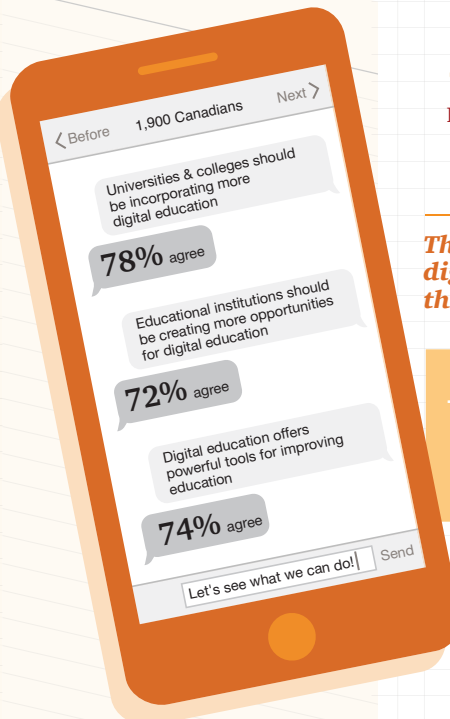

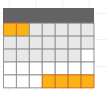
