About Clothesline[®]

Clothesline[®] is an innovative program that reaches out to millions of individuals in more than a thousand communities across Canada. Clothesline[®] collects gently used clothing, small household items and electronics from our generous donors. Household pick-ups are free and can be arranged by calling **1-800-505-5525** or by visiting **diabetes.ca/promise**. All proceeds raised by Clothesline[®] directly supports the Canadian Diabetes Association and world-class diabetes research, advocacy efforts and important programs such as D-Camps for children and youth living with type 1 diabetes.

Items accepted as donations include clothing, linens, shoes, toys, books, small appliances, kitchenware, small electronics, cell phones, laptops, game consoles and much more. Just about anything that clutters garages, basements, attics and closets. The Association currently has 30 Clothesline[®] offices across Canada from British Columbia to NewFoundland (with the exception of Quebec).

The Clothesline[®] program has been operating across Canada since 1985. Each year, more than 48 million kilograms of clothing, household and electronic items are diverted from Canadian landfill. This is equivalent to saving 8.6 million trees each year or driving a compact car around the globe 43,000 times!
